



Abbott Fletcher Manana Island Course Trophy

Awarded to Manana Island Race First Overall Yacht



In 1962, the official name of the five-year-old Manana Island Race was established with the donation of the Manana Island Trophy bowl from Mrs. Ernest J Ballard of Chebeague Island.

In 2000, the PYC dedicated the Manana Island Race to the memory of Abbott Fletcher and rededicated the Manana Island Trophy as the Abbott Fletcher Trophy. From 1965 to 1999, Abbott Fletcher sailed in thirty-four consecutive Monhegan Island races on his boat "Majek". His final, twelfth, victory was in 1999.
