



THE AMARYLLIS **TROPHY**

Awarded to Monhegan
Island Race first to finish
Multihull



"Amaryllis" was the first multihull boat design by Nathaneal Herreshoft and built by John Brown Herreshoft in 1875. This boat was excluded from competition with monohull boats by the New York Yacht Club in 1876. This trophy endeavors to ensure that multihulls are recognized, as an important component in the racing fabric of Casco-Bay.

Richard Saltonstall presented the trophy to Monhegan Island Race multihull contestants in 2000 to insure that their participation was honored even when competing against monohull yachts.
